The Utah Public Health Association (UPHA) is taking nominations for Utah Public Health Hero/Heroine awards. This award will be presented at the annual *Utah Public Health Conference* on Wednesday, April 6, 2011 at the South Towne Expo Center in Sandy, Utah.

The nomination deadline is: Monday, March 7, 2011.

There are three categories for the Utah Public Health Hero/Heroine Award. The categories are:

- An individual from the community.
- A public health employee.
- A group, organization, or a project.

The following is the criteria for each category:

Individual from the community

- The individual's main job is not in public health.
- The individual has raised awareness of public health issues.
- The individual has been willing to take a stand/risk relating to public health.
- The individual has proven exceptional service to the community.

Public Health Employee

- The employee's main job is in public health at the State, local, or community level.
- The employee's efforts have been over and above their regular work assignment.
- The employee has shown leadership/courage.
- The employee has made a difference in public health.

*Group/Organization/Project**

- The group/organization/project has made a significant impact on public health.
- The group/organization/project is unusually creative or innovative.
- The group/organization/project involves multiple people.

*The group/organization/project can include Utah Department of Health programs.
