Description

The recipient of the **Rising Star in Public Health Award** will be an individual who demonstrates leadership in the public health field. Individuals nominated for this award should be making a significant contribution to the advancement of health within a community, or to the knowledge and practice in the public health field. They must demonstrate commitment, use new approaches in conducting public health, or work creatively in applying scientific knowledge to the field. Nominees should be new to public health, having worked in this area for no more than 3 years.

The recipient of this award will be selected by the UPHA Awards Committee. **The deadline for nominating individuals for this award is Wednesday, April 7, 2010.**

This award will be presented at the annual Utah Public Health Conference on May 12, 2010 at the Zermott Hotel & Conference Center in Midway, Utah.
